

Special Olympics South Carolina engages communities across SC to provide opportunities for individuals with intellectual disabilities in the area of sports, health and education. These opportunities also bring together thousands of volunteers, families and other community partners to develop more inclusive communities. The Sports and Education Outreach Initiative will utilize Special Olympics programs and events to maximize and reach and impact on Special Olympics athletes, their families and members of communities statewide. Special Olympics will also focus on building capacity to serve an increased number of athletes with more opportunities in sustainable and responsible ways. INITIATIVE 1: Increase Special Olympics Athlete, Family and Volunteer Outreach, by (a) engaging Special Olympics athlete leaders and their families/advocates through quarterly Athlete Townhall Meetings and additional leadership trainings, (b) increasing access to resources through improved digital resources and website as platform for sharing, (c) implementing a marketing plan for recruiting more volunteers, and (d) improving onboarding system for volunteers; INITIATIVE 2: Support innovative events that promote Unified Sports and social inclusion in Unified Champion Schools; INITIATIVE 3: Provide Special Olympics sports opportunities at local and state levels including (a) 2x State Games events, (b) 2x NEW Regional state-hosted sports tournaments or invitationals, (c) support NEW Unified Sports leagues at local level, and (d) 16x competition events hosted by area programs.


