The requesting division will be notified promptly of the final action concerning the position. No definite commitment should be made to a prospective employee pending final notification.

New positions and existing positions are normally filled or refilled at the minimum salary of the appropriate band/level. It is recognized that qualifications and experience of an employee and conditions of the labor market may, at times, justify a higher starting salary. In such cases, Division Directors/District Directors/Facility Administrators may request an above the minimum salary, subject to final approval of the DDSN Central Office Human Resources Director and/or DISTRICT II
