


Case Management



Helps people find their way through complicated systems to reach their goals.




Genetic Testing

Financial assistance for families.




Family Arranged Respite



DDSN Waiver Basics

- Three Waivers
- Participation is Voluntary
- Automatic Placement on Waitlists
- Must meet LOC Requirements
- At least 2 services every 30 days
- "Waiver Hopping"

Community Supports Waiver

- Respite
- Employment Supports
- Day Program
- In-Home Supports



ID/RD Waiver

- Incontinence Supplies
- Day Activity


Eligibility Categories

- Intellectual Disability
- Related Disability

 (i.e., a disability related to an Intellectual Disability)
- High-Risk Infant/At-Risk Child
- Autism Spectrum Disorder
- Head Injury
- Spinal Cord Injury
- Similar Disability

(i.e., a disability similar to head [traumatic brain] or spinal cord injury)




DDSN announces:






