RE: Market Rate Case Management Issue – January 2019 Billing Reports

Attached are the following reports: January 2019 Billing Efficiency Report; Sensitivity Analysis of Case Management Market Rate Risk; and a new report titled, "Analysis of High and Low Billing Rates from June 2018 to January 2019." This new report shows your agency's range of billing over the time period (dotted line) and the current month (bold dot). This should be useful in comparing this month to previous months as well as showing a quick glance of the range of your billing.

The January 2019 Billing Efficiency Report average provider market rate revenue was 51.5% of the current monthly capitated band payment. This month showed significant improvement over the past months as we move out of the Holiday season. The billing this month is comparable to the billing last October, which was elevated by a high concentration of annual plans due to the ramp up to Therap in 2017.

This month we will also be sending a summary to each Executive Director/CEO containing a financial summary of the last 6 months billing compared to what was paid as a band payment. This communication will show, in actual dollar amounts, what was paid from July-December and what would have been paid if the new rates were in effect. This will help each Director better assess the current situation of their Case Management Program.


Below is a chart of each month's average provider market rate revenue compared to the current monthly capitated band payment since the beginning of tracking this issue.
