Fiscal Agent Transition to Electronic Forms

The purpose of this memo is to notify case management providers that Morning Sun Financial Services, the current fiscal agent for participant-directed services including Adult Attendant Care, In Home Supports, and Respite, will be transitioning to the use of electronic enrollment forms. The purpose of this transition is to streamline the fiscal agent enrollment process and to allow both the employees and employers of participant-directed services to easily access the forms needed for enrollment and to complete and sign forms electronically.

The platform used provides step-by-step guidance for the completion of the forms and allows for a more efficient enrollment experience.
