SUBJECT: COVID-19 Reporting Modules

Over the past 18 months, providers have been submitting Critical Incident Reports to document positive COVID-19 infections among people supported by their agency. As we move into the New Year, we want to shift to a different model for reporting that will reduce documentation for providers.

Effective immediately, residential and day service providers will submit documentation of positive COVID-19 infections among service recipients via the GER Module on Therap. The GER Module has a specific category for COVID-19 Reporting, which will streamline reporting efforts and eliminate the need for final report documentation through the Critical Incident process. Reports of staff infections with COVID-19 will continue to be reported using the HRST COVID Reporting tool.
