Market Rate Case Management Issue - April 2019 Billing Report RE:

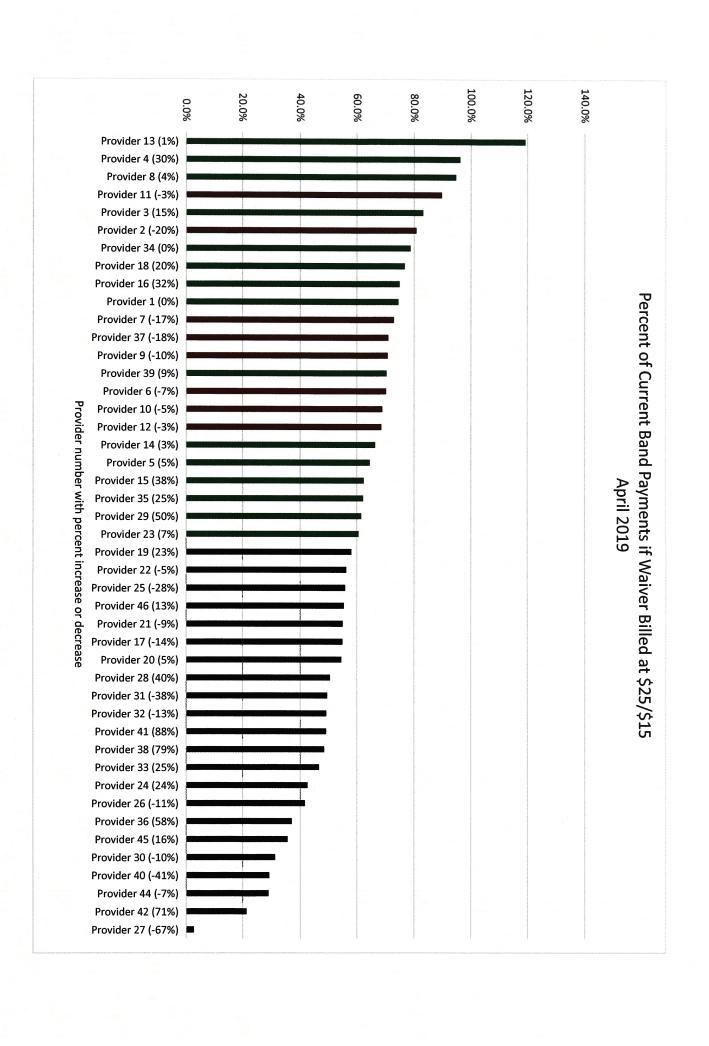
Attached are the following reports: April 2019 Billing Efficiency Report; Sensitivity Analysis of Case Management Market Rate Risk; and "Analysis of High and Low Billing Rates from June 2018 to April 2019."

The April 2019 Billing Efficiency Report average provider market rate revenue was 63.8% of the current monthly capitated band payment. Below is a chart of each month's average provider market rate revenue compared to the current monthly capitated band payment since the beginning of tracking this issue.
