1. Call to Order

5. Review Minutes from the February 12, 2024, Meeting

<u>Brief Summary</u>: The minutes from the September 13, 2023, meeting were presented to the committee for approval.

<u>Committee Vote(s) (if any)</u>: Commissioner Kocher made a motion to approve the minutes as written; seconded by Commissioner Miller. The minutes were unanimously approved by the Committee.

6. Financial Approval & Threshold Report

Quincy Swygert

Brief Summary: Quincy Swygert presented two (2) items for review by the committee. The first item was a new, non-service contract for the condition assessments of fifty-seven (57) DDSN Owned Community Properties. The 3rd party assessments will document the current conditions of each building and make recommendations on the needed renovations of each building and to provide construction estimates. A final report prioritizing the needs of the 57 properties will be issued to DDSN. That report will be used to request capital reserve or non-recurring funds in the General Assembly's 2026 Appropriation Request. The decision by DDSN to assess the properties and move forward with extricate comes from a recommendation made during the House Legislative Oversight Process. The agency either no longer receives or will soon no longer receive recurring funds to maintain these properties. Mr. Swygert will present the information to the providers at the June 24 provider's meeting.

The second item was the renewal of the janitorial/housekeeping services contract at the Coastal Regional Center. It is proposed that the new contract will span three years with a total value of \$250,000 (\$83,000). The agency projects an 8% increase in the current contract which is \$75,000 per year.

<u>Committee Vote(s) (if any)</u>: On a motion by Commissioner Miller, seconded Commissioner Kocher, the Committee approved the two budget proposals. These budget proposals will be brought to the full commission for approval at the Thursday, June 20th meeting.

7. Chief Financial Updates:

Quincy Swygert

FY24 YTD Spending Plan Budget vs. Actual Expenditures – Thru May 2024

<u>Brief Summary:</u> Mr. Swygert presented the FY24 Spending Plan Budget vs. Actual Expenditures through May 31, 2024. To date, the Agency has expended \$314.6 million, which is 95.50% of the Agency's proposed spending plan of \$329.4 million, with 8.33% of the spending plan remaining. The agency is 3.84% over budget.

FY25 Contracts Over \$200,000 Approval

<u>Brief Summary:</u> Mr. Swygert presented information on the eight (8) FY24 contracts that have an end date of June 30, 2024. With the exception of the University of South Carolina (USC) — Center for Disabilities (CDR) contract, the amounts for the other seven (7) contracts will remain the same. The USC - CDR contract will increase from \$200,000 to \$225,000 for the 2025 fiscal year.

<u>Committee Vote(s) (if any)</u>: On a motion by Commissioner Miller, seconded Commissioner Kocher, the Committee approved the increase and the renewal of the USC – CDR contract and the renewal of the additional seven (7) contracts. The budget proposals will be brought to the full commission for approval at the Thursday, June 20th meeting.

9. Internal Audit Update

Courtney Crosby

<u>Brief Summary:</u> Ms. Crosby presented the proposed FY25 Internal Audit Plan. The FY25 Internal Audit Plan document was discussed in detail and presented to the Commission members present. The audit plan is an outline of individual audit projects to be conducted throughout the year. The audit projects are divided into and two separate engagements areas (DDSN and provider network). Ms. Crosby reminded the committee that the audit plan is designed to be flexible and can be updated based on changes in priority and resources. Should there be a need to make any significant changes to the audit plan, those changes will be presented to the committee for their review and approval.

A new tracking report was presented to the committee at the beginning of last month. The new tracking report follows up on DDSN Promised Initiatives in response to Part 2 of the LAC Report and provides statistics on both completed and outstanding promised initiatives. The committee will receive an update on the new tracking report and the Internal Audit Observation Tracking Report in early July.
