RE: Continued DDSN Grant Funding of HASCI Community Opportunity Centers and Previous Rehabilitation Supports Providers Electing to Convert to Waiver Funded Day Program Services

As noted in the September 24, 2020, memo entitled "Continued DDSN Grant Funding of HASCI Community Opportunity Centers and Previous Rehabilitation Supports Providers Electing to Convert to Waiver Funded Day Program Services," former RS providers are expected to re-evaluate their plans for achieving self-sufficiency and apply concerted efforts over the second quarter of this fiscal year. As a tool to aid providers in assessing progress, monthly utilization reports will be provided to all former RS providers to demonstrate effort and progress. DDSN will evaluate this data over the course of the second quarter, and the amount of continued support funding that each provider will be awarded for the third quarter of the fiscal year will be determined individually based on demonstrated progress and effort.

September's usage information is attached. When compared to August's data, there was an increase of 25.7% in the number of individuals served across all providers, with one provider making a substantial increase in the number of individuals served by 38.4%. Regarding the number of units billed, in comparison to August's data, 35.6% more units were billed across all providers, with one provider more than doubling billed units, while two others slightly declined.

In a post COVID-19 world, DDSN understands that increases in individuals served, and therefore billing, will be incremental. The incremental increases from August to September reveal that efforts are being made toward provider self-sufficiency. Thank you for your continued efforts.
