RE: HASCI Waiver Service Survey

The purpose of this correspondence is to request the assistance of HASCI Case Managers with the completion of a HASCI Waiver service survey.

As you may be aware, DDSN will no longer be a provider of HASCI Rehabilitation Supports (RS) effective March 1, 2020. A transition plan has been implemented and includes transitioning current RS recipients to waiver funded services including Day Activity and Career Preparation. While access to these services will be beneficial to current RS service recipients, these services will not replace the individualized skill building component of RS.

In an effort to determine whether a waiver amendment is needed to add an individual skill building service, DDSN seeks to learn more about the needs and desires of current RS participants and HASCI Waiver participants in general. We need the input of current service recipients, and are asking that as a method of assessing need, Waiver Case Managers review this survey with all HASCI Waiver participants as a part of their monthly WCM contact requirement. We also ask that Case Managers review this survey with those current RS recipients who are not yet enrolled in the HASCI Waiver as method of assessing need.
